

## NCLB Parent Report Card 2009

As required by the federal government and TEA, Colorado ISD is creating parent access via the district website for all Title I information, including the following:

- Assessment results for 2007-2008
  - AEIS report from last year covers this requirement
  - Performance levels for the past two years
  - Comparison between annual objectives and actual performance for each student group
  - Percentage of students not tested
  - Graduation rates for secondary students
- Adequate Yearly Progress performance for 2007-2008
  - CISD did not meet AYP for last year in the area of math and reading with the subgroup population of special education
  - All individual schools in the CISD did meet AYP
- No school is identified as “in need of improvement” by the federal government
- Highly Qualified Teachers and Paraprofessionals percentage—schools are presenting the following percentages of Highly Qualified staff members:
  - Kelley Elementary—100% of teachers and 87% of paraprofessionals (new hires in 08-09 School Year; will complete training in summer 09)
  - Hutchinson Elementary—100% teachers and 95% of paraprofessionals (new hire in 09; will complete training in summer 09)
  - Colorado Middle School—98% teachers and 100% of paraprofessionals
  - Colorado High School—100% teachers and paraprofessionals
  - Wallace Accelerated School—100% teachers and paraprofessionals
